



Pondage-Wide Directions

- Maintain the vegetation along the shoreline to maximise views from walking paths and access for fishing
- Increase indigenous tree planting throughout
- Install information and directional signage as required, and interpretive signage at locations of historical significance or of educational value (environmental, flora, fauna)
- Install occasional bench seating along all paths throughout the Eildon Pondage precinct
- Floating pontoons and fixed platforms to be accessible, and include solar lighting and 1 - 2 bench seats with backs

Lions Park

- 29 New safe pedestrian crossing point
- 31 Reconfigure the car park to include some trailer parking and a new path
- 32 Reconfigure the angle car parking and path
- 33 New stage (project underway)
- 34 Vehicle-free area. Paved central plaza providing for:
 - Orientation/direction to key destinations
 - Seating
 - Management vehicle access/turning/loading
- 35 Form new angled car parking with bollards or similar to prevent vehicles from accessing the grass areas
